# OUTDOOR SUMMER SAFETY PLAN



*Skyline is committed to the safety and well being of our customers and employees. Effective June 1, 2020, Skyline will put in place our Outdoor Summer Safety Plan.*

*We are implementing several new operational and safety changes.*

## EMPLOYEES

### SERVING YOU SAFELY

- Before starting work
  - All staff must pass temperature screening
  - Hands sanitized when arrive
- During shift
  - All staff wears masks
  - Hands constantly washed

# FOR OUR CUSTOMERS & PLAYERS



## PLAYERS

### NO FEVERS ALLOWED

- All customers must pass temperature screening
- Hands sanitized at the door

### DISTANCED SOCIALIZING

- Limited number of teams per night
- Spaced out game times
- Socially distanced seating

### WE WASH OUR BALLS

- All equipment sanitized between games
- Players sanitize before games

# VOLLEYBALL SAFETY



## Precautionary measures

- Temperature screening at the door
- Sanitizing hands at the door
- Spaced out game times – now 6pm, 7pm, 8pm, & 9pm
- Limited amount of teams in leagues

## Before every game

- All players must sanitize hands
- Ref sanitizes volleyballs (warm up & game ball)
- Sanitize drink holders after each game

## During every game

- Pre-game captains meeting with ref > maintain proper social distancing
- When switching sides, teams must stay 6ft apart
- Strongly encourage all players to do their best to maintain social distancing

## **NO MINNESOTA NICE**

- If opposing ball comes into your court, please *kick* the ball back (don't pick it up and throw back)
- NO shaking hands between games (distant air fives recommended)

# BOCCE SAFETY



## Precautionary measures

- Temperature screening at the door
- Sanitizing hands at the door

## Before every game

- All players must sanitize hands (sanitization station at each court)
- Ref sanitizes bocce balls, pallino, and scoreboard
- Sanitize drink holders & tables after each game

## During every game

- Add numbered stickers to the bocce ball (and only player 1 picks up their own numbered ball)
- Coin toss with ref > maintain proper social distancing
- Social distancing markers to keep non-throwing players spread out
- Only captains can change YOUR own score (don't change other team's score)
- Strongly encourage all players to do their best to maintain social distancing

## NO MINNESOTA NICE

- PLEASE only pick up your own numbered ball
- NO shaking hands after games (distant air fives recommended)

# BAGS SAFETY



## Precautionary measures

- Temperature screening at the door
- Sanitizing hands at the door

## Before every game

- All players must sanitize hands (sanitization station at each court)
- Ref sanitizes boards, sprays bags, and scoreboard
- Sanitize drink holders after each game

## During every game

- Only can change YOUR own score. Don't change other team's score
- Strongly encourage all players to do their best to maintain social distancing

## **NO MINNESOTA NICE**

- Only grab your own team's bags. Don't touch the other bags when adding up the score
- NO shaking hands after games (distant air fives recommended)

# Spikeball Safety



## Precautionary measures

- Temperature screening at the door
- Sanitizing hands at the door

## Before every game

- All players must sanitize hands
- Ref sanitizes balls
- Sanitize drink holders after each game

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



## Are we still starting June 1?

- No. But we're *opening outdoor seating starting Monday, June 1*. Call to make your reservation. For leagues, a new start date will be announced soon after discussions with the city and health experts.

## What if my temperature is too high?

- Recommend you take your temperature before driving here
- 100.4 or higher > directed to additional entrance for rescreening
- Not allowed to enter if too high
- Anyone who arrived with is also not allowed to enter

## How are you washing other material?

- We're sanitizing our tables between each small group
- All used menus will be discarded in the "to clean" pile. All menus will be disinfected before



# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



## **Do all customers & players have to wear masks?**

- As of now, we recommend masks but that might change when leagues start. In any social situation, there is a chance that the 6ft distance can be compromised. We recommend everyone be cautious of their space and keep your distance whenever possible.

## **How will refunds work?**

- For teams that have signed up and paid in advance, we will refund your team when leagues start (after we know how much to refund).
- For unpaid teams, a discount will be applied to your invoice based on missed weeks due to postponement.

## **When can we play inside?**

- Skyline will continue to follow COVID-19 recommendations, evolving safety policies throughout the summer to best manage customer health and experience. For indoor entertainment, plans will be outlined soon.
